

Dr. Carmen Gill

Dr. Carmen Gill is a professor in the Department of Sociology at the University of New Brunswick. Dr. Gill works in partnership with police agencies in Canada. Her research focuses on police intervention in intimate partner violence (IPV), domestic homicide and treatment of perpetrators and victims through the criminal justice system. Dr. Carmen Gill is currently leading a three years national research project entitled: Coercive control, risk assessment and evidence of intimate partner violence: Police response in partnership with the Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police (CACP), the Canadian Police Knowledge Network (CPKN) and l'École nationale de police du Québec. She is a member of the Canadian observatory on Femicide.

Dr. Carmen Gill was the leader of the Canadian observatory on the justice system response to intimate partner violence (2006-2016). She led the development of the national framework for collaborative police action on IPV with CACP. She also conducted a research on domestic homicide in New Brunswick for the period of 1999 to 2018.
